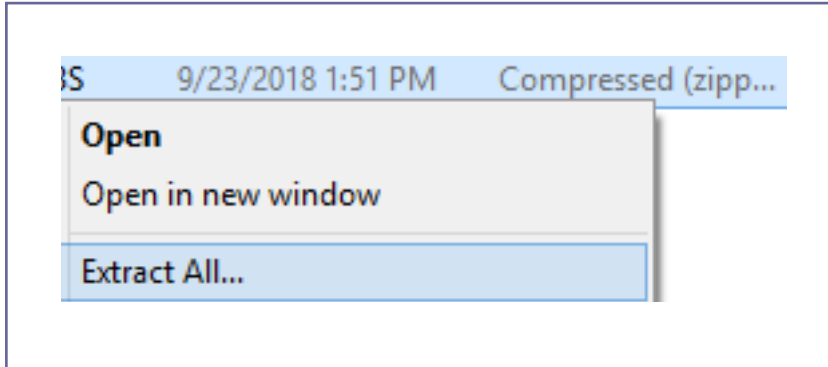

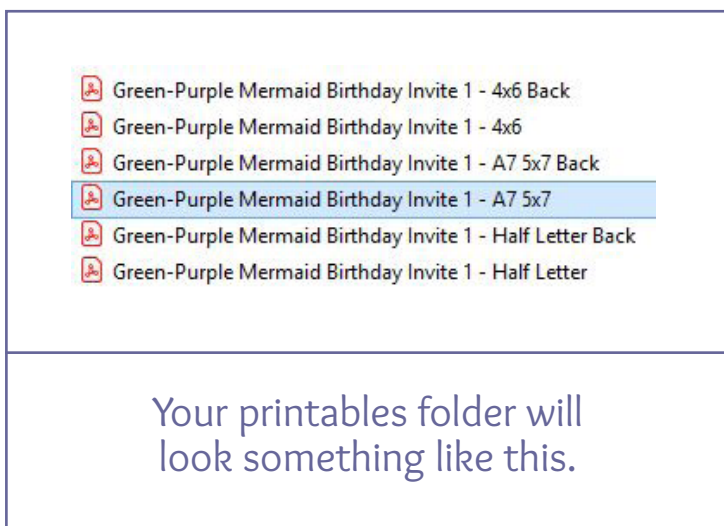

Step 1: Extract printable files from the .zip file

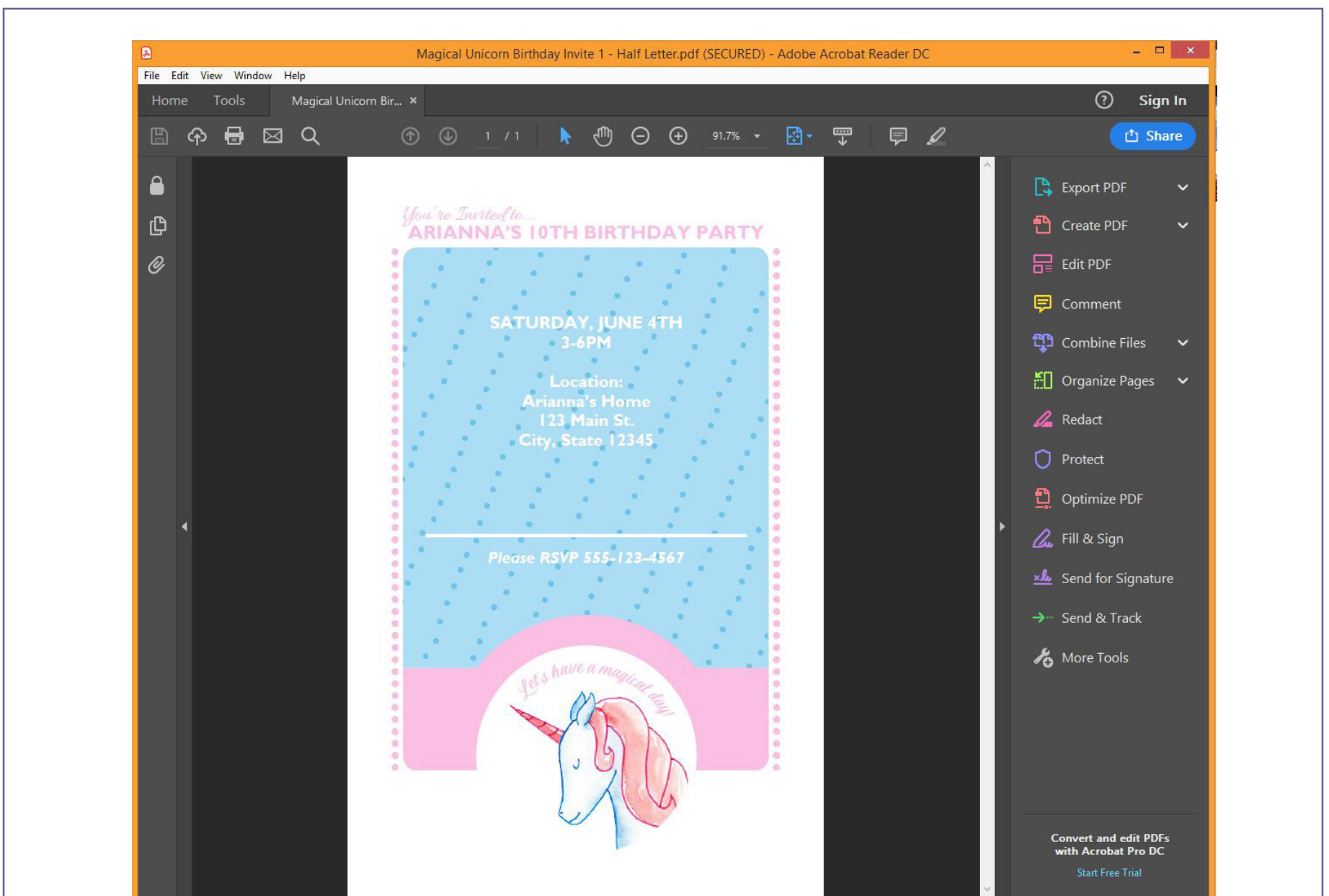


You'll find a .zip file along with this instruction file. The .zip file contains your printable files. You will have to extract the files before you can edit them. On most computers, you can simply right-click the file and select, "Extract All..." If the option for extracting isn't present, you'll need to download a program to extract .zip files like 7-Zip or WinZip.

Step 2: Open and edit your correct file size



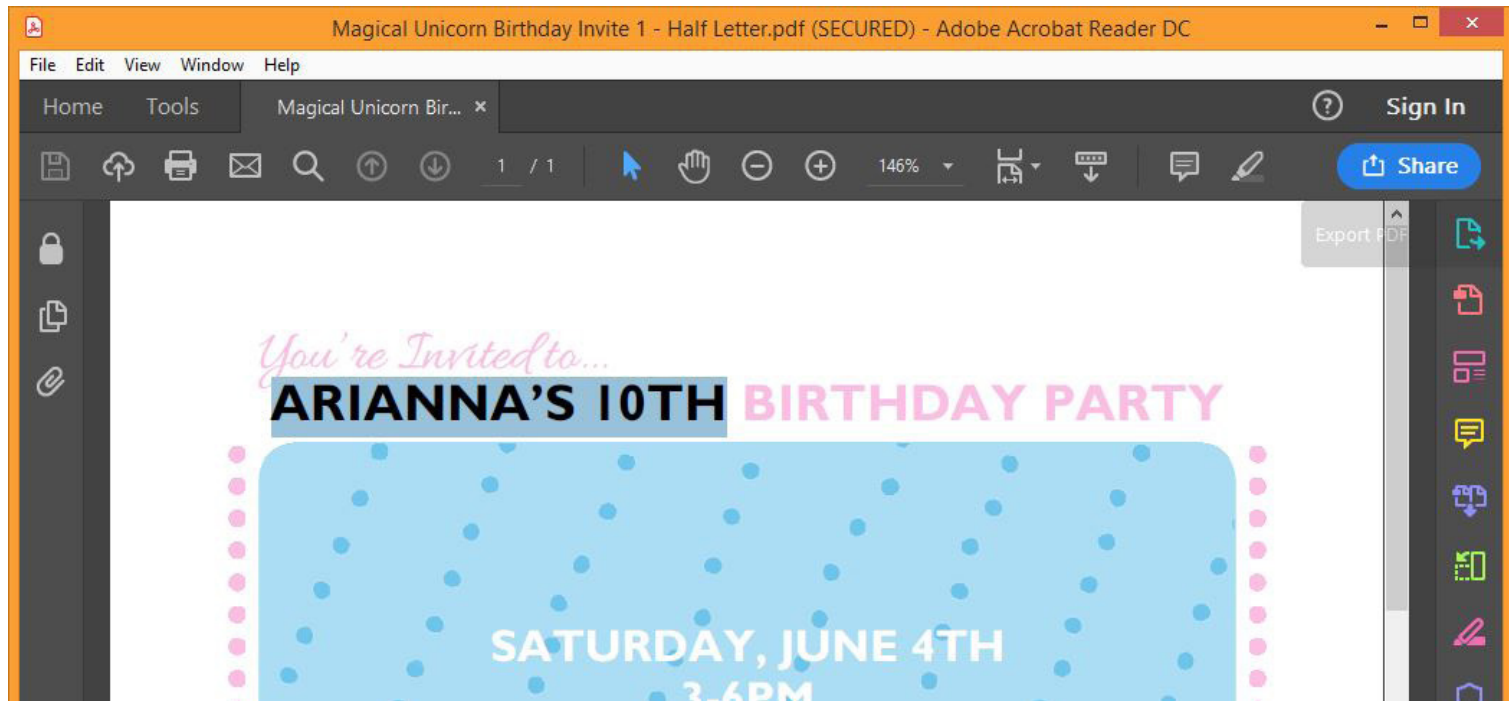
I've included several sizes to choose from. Pick the correct file size for your paper and open it in Adobe Acrobat. Most versions of Adobe Acrobat should work. In the below example, I'm using Adobe Acrobat DC.



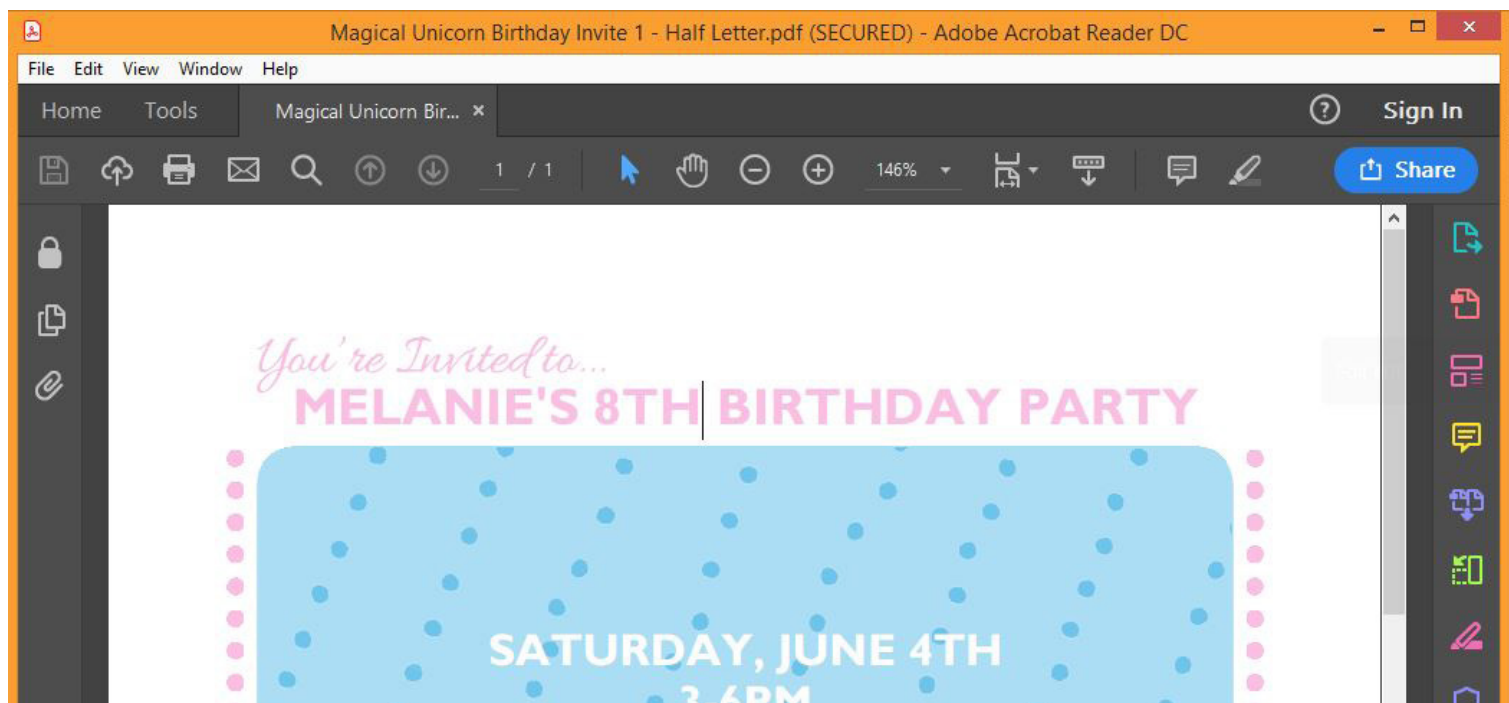
The printable file open in Adobe Acrobat DC

Step 3: Edit the file

Select the text you'd like to edit. Not all of the text is editable. Please check the "Troubleshooting" file to see what text you can edit.

Step 4: Print

Best printed at actual size. The printer might warn you about the image being too large, but it's fine. You can still print at actual size.
